

The pastor of a Protestant village, André urged the community to uphold their religious values and to help their Jewish neighbors. He inspired villagers from the area to save more than 3,500 Jews, many of whom were smuggled to the Swiss border.



Raoul Wallenberg

A Swedish diplomat in Budapest, Raoul issued protective passports to Jews and created safe houses to shelter them. He recruited a staff of hundreds and worked with other diplomats, saving tens of thousands of Jews from deportation.
