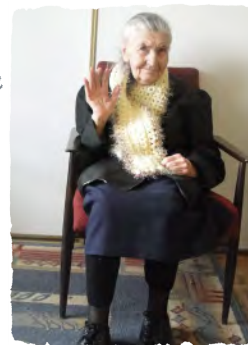


THE JFR CHARITY KNITTING PROJECT
